



# Church

# Church


(SUGGESTED INSTRUCTIONS)

Lay all the pieces out and label them before cutting or gluing.

1. Using templates made out of cardboard cut out all doors (Front, Middle and Back) and windows (in all Wall Pieces) - save the left over pieces for Headstones.
2. Glue one 100mm Side Wall next to one 75mm Side Wall. Repeat to form the two Side Walls of the Church. The entrance goes on later.
3. Glue a Vault piece onto a Middle and Back Wall then cut the angle on the Vault from the top middle to the outside corners of the Vault to make the pitch for the roof. Some overhang is needed to allow for the thickness of the walls. (You may want to Glue the Vaulted Roof together and leave unattached from the Walls so the Roof can be removed to access the inside of the Church.)
4. Glue the Middle and Back pieces to the inside of the Side Walls to make a rectangle then glue on the Roof ( if intended) - overlapping at the top so there is no gap. You now have a simple Church building. Position on the Base to one side and glue down. This will leave space for the Graveyard.
5. Glue the Entrance to the inside of the two Side Walls, then glue on the Roof.
6. Glue this Entrance Structure to the front of the Church making sure all Side Walls are aligned.
7. Glue the pieces of the Bell Tower together making sure the front and back pieces are inside the Side Walls. Make a hole in the ceiling so you can thread some cotton through it and hang the Bell in the Tower.
8. Glue the Steeple to the Bell Tower and to the top of the Church entrance.
9. Cut a 45 degree angle on the top of 6 pieces of Buttress and glue 3 to each side of the building under the main roof.
10. Cut one of the pieces of 6.5mm stick to make a Cross and attach to the top of the Steeple.
11. Use the rest of the 6.5mm sticks to make Window Sills and Steps around the Church
12. With the cut out pieces of doors and windows make Headstones for the Graveyard next to the Church.

## Finish the model off by

- Make shingles for the roof from cardboard or use corrugated cardboard for an iron-look roof.
- Make some pigeons for the Bell Tower from painted clay.
- Make some pews and an alter for the church from balsa wood.
- Attach some vegetation (real or fake) around the site to look like an over grown church yard.
- Write an epitaph on each of the headstones.
- Make some stained glass windows from Cellophane.
- Write a prayer or a thought on a small piece of paper and keep it in the church.
